Proposed Provision of Playground at Rusheeny and Hazelbury, Dublin 15

In accordance with Part VIII of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001, Fingal County Council hereby gives notice of its intention to provide a playground on the public open spaces at Hazelbury Park and Rusheeny, Dublin 15.

Hazelbury Park Playground will be 300 square metres in area, the boundary will be secured with a 1.2 metres high railing, play equipment will be suitable for children under 12 years of age only and a safety surface will be provided in the critical fall areas around each piece of equipment.

Rusheeny Playground will be 220 square metres in area, the boundary will be secured with a 1.2 metre high railing, play equipment will be suitable for children under 8 years of age only and a safety surface will be provided in the critical fall areas around each of the equipment.

Plans and particulars of the proposed development will be made available for inspection between the hours of **9.00 a.m. to 5.00p.m. Monday to Thursday and 9.00a.m. to 4.30 p.m. on Fridays from Wednesday 20th January 2010 until Wednesday 3rd March 2010** at (a) The Parks Division, Fingal County Council, County Hall, Main Street, Swords and (b) Fingal County Council Offices at Grove road, Blanchardstown.
