TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ROADS IN SKERRIES

An application has been received from Loughshinny Motorcycle Supporters Club Limited for permission to temporarily close roads in the Skerries area for the purpose of holding the annual Killalane Road motorcycle race. The application is for the public roads to be closed on Saturday 11th September 2010 from 1.00 p.m. to 7.00 p.m. and on Sunday 12th September 2010 from 10.00 a.m. to 6.30 p.m.

The roads in question are:-

1. St. Monica's Road
2. Blackhill to Balcunnin, from the junction with St. Monica's Road to the junction with Blake's Cross/Skerries Road
3. Blake's Cross/Skerries Road from the junction with Blackhill/Balcunnin Road to the junction with Knock Cross to Balcunnin Road
4. Knock Cross to Balcunnin road from the junction with Blake's Cross/Skerries Road to the junction with Killalane Road
5. Killalane Road from the junction with Knock Cross/Balcunnin Road to the junction with St. Monica's Road

The main diversion route for vehicles travelling from Lusk to Skerries is via the main roads — Lusk to Rush and Rush to Skerries.

Other alternative routes are:-

Balbriggan/Balrothery to Lusk

- Drogheda Road (old N1)(R132) to the Five Roads Junction, Hedgestown Lane, Quickpenny Road to Lusk Village **or**
- Balbriggan Road (R127) to Skerries and Rush-Skerries Road (R128) to Rush and Lusk-Rush Road (R128) to Lusk

Balbriggan/Balrothery to Rush

Via Lusk — the main Lusk to Rush Road.
