ROADS ACT 1993 — SECTION 75

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PART OF CHANNEL ROAD, (OUTSIDE SCHOOL) RUSH

An application has been received from Volkerinfra Ltd. for permission to temporarily close part of Channel Road, Rush from the junction at Mill Bank to the junction at Chapel Green to facilitate works being undertaken by Volkerinfra Ltd.

The road will be closed between Monday the 18th April 2011 and Friday 29th April 2011 inclusive to co-incide with school Easter holidays.

Local access will be facilitated where possible and extensive diversion and information signage will be in place.

- During the works it will not be possible for traffic approaching Rush town centre to pass the primary school on Channel Road

The alternative route for traffic is as follows;

- Traffic moving in the direction of the town centre must turn left at Millbank and drive clockwise around Chapel Green until it meets Sandy Road at the Church car park.
- Traffic travelling out of Rush can travel as normal down Channel Road past the school.
- Millbank will remain a one way street as normal.

Any interested person may lodge an objection in writing with the Senior Executive Officer, Transportation Department, Fingal County Council, Grove Road, Blanchardstown, Dublin 15 to arrive no later than 4.30p.m. on Monday 1st April 2011.
