NOTICE OF THE MAKING OF BYE LAWS FOR THE PIERS AND HARBOURS OF FINGAL COUNTY

In accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Act 2001 section 201, and Section 89 of the Harbours Act 1996 Fingal County Council hereby gives notice of the making of Harbour Bye Laws for Balbriggan and Skerries Harbours.

And

In accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Act 2001 section 201 and the Maritime Safety Act 2005 Section 6 Fingal County Council hereby gives notice of the making of Harbour Bye Laws for Loughshinny and Rush piers.

The purpose of these Bye Laws is to

- a)** protect and preserve the harbours as a functional amenity and as a listed structure under the County Development Plan
- b)** regulate the activity of the harbour for the benefit of all users and maintain order
- c)** provide for the viability of these harbours by introducing a system of revenue collection

These Bye Laws will come in to force on Friday 14th January 2011
