

**NEWS RELEASE –**

**ESSENTIAL ROADWORKS ON SWORDS/MALAHIDE ROAD FROM 20th JUNE UNTIL END AUGUST**

Fingal County Council Water Services Department commences essential works on the **Swords/Malahide Road from the 20<sup>th</sup> June 2011**. The section of this road which the works will be carried out on is from **Waterside to Malahide Demesne**. **This work is expected to be ongoing until the end of August.**

The works entail laying a 450mm watermain along this stretch of road to facilitate the upgrade of the Malahide Reservoir. Please note that following the pipe laying the road will be left with a temporary surface for a period to ensure settlement of the pipe and surrounds, at which stage the road will be permanently resurfaced. While these works are being carried out the road will be reduced to one lane and will be traffic light managed.

Citizens using this road will experience delays throughout this period.

Road signs informing the public of the works will be erected on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> June. These signs will be located on the Swords side before the roundabout where the Feltrim Road meets the Malahide Road as you travel over the M1 and on the Malahide side near the entrance to Malahide Park. The detour signs will be erected on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> June.
