PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS 2001 - 2009

Proposed erection of a Public Art Piece, 'THE HIDE SCULPTURE' on the Broadmeadow Estuary, Estuary Road, Swords, Co. Dublin.

In accordance with Part XI of the Planning and Development Acts 2000 to 2006 and Part 8 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 - 2009, Fingal County Council hereby gives notice of the proposed development as follows:

The Arts Office of Fingal County Council is proposing the erection of a Permanent sculpture in the form of a functioning Bird Hide at the above location with associated site works as part of the 'Per Cent for art scheme'. The Bird Hide fabricated in cast concrete will stand approx 3.5m in height and will be sited on an earth mound with concrete stilts. The surface of the Bird Hide will be rendered to give a realistic wooden effect that compliments the environment.

As required by Article 81 of the 2001 Regulations, as amended by Article 17(2) of the 2006 Regulations, plans and particulars of the development, indicating the proposed amendments, will be available for inspection, or purchase at a fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy thereof, from Thursday 23rd June, 2011 to Friday 5th August, 2011 at:

- ii) Malahide Library, Main Street, Malahide, Co. Dublin during the opening hours**
