PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS 2001 - 2011

Proposed construction of a sports hall with ancillary accommodation for the Melrose/Kinsealy area with associated site works and services on a site off the Feltrim road, Swords, Fingal, Co. Dublin and adjacent to the Swords Enterprise Park.

In accordance with Part XI of the Local Government Planning and Development Acts 2000 to 2010 and Part 8 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 - 2011, Fingal County Council hereby gives notice of the proposed development as follows:

The construction of a sports hall comprising a multi-purpose sports hall (4 badminton courts & a basketball court) of 605m² with associated stores and ancillary accommodation (560m²) on two floors providing shower & changing rooms, umpire room, toilets, Reception desk, Manager's office and control room, two meeting rooms with stores, a tea station and seating area together with public toilets and all associated site works and landscaping.

As required by Article 81 of the 2001 Regulations, as amended by Article 17(2) of the 2006 Regulations, plans and particulars of the development, indicating the proposed amendments, will be available for inspection, or purchase at a fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy thereof, from Thursday 15th December, 2011 to Thursday 26th January, 2012 at:

iii) St. Finians Rivervalley Community Centre, Rivervalley, Swords, Co. Dublin between the hours of 9.00am-12.00am Mon-Sun (Community Centre closed 25.12.2011)
