3. Public Liability Insurance of €6.35 million with a specific indemnity to Fingal County Council must be submitted.
4. Proof of delivery of written notice by the Applicant to any adjoining property owner and/or any tenant in any of the buildings in the ownership of the Applicant, which are affected by this application.
5. Cheque in the amount of €1,250.00 made payable to Fingal County Council. The Licence fee of €1,250.00 is listed under Schedule 12 of the Planning & Development Regulations 2001.

If any of these documents are omitted, the application will be deemed invalid and returned to the Applicant.
