PROPOSED TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF STATION ROAD, PORTMARNOCK, CO DUBLIN

An application has been made for the temporary closure of Station Road, Portmarnock. **The road closure will involve closing Station Road between Drumnigh Road (R124) and Coast Road (R106).** The purpose of this closure is to facilitate Bridge and Road widening works associated with Station Road upgrading, at Portmarnock. Local access will be maintained for the duration of the closure.

The period of the proposed temporary closure is **Saturday 25th April at 4.00 pm until Sunday 26th April 2009 at 07.00 am.**

The alternative routes for vehicular traffic will be as follows:

Diversion via Coast Road, Moyne Road and Drumnigh Road.

High sided vehicles follow diversion via Coast Road, Willie Nolan Road (Baldoyle), Grange Road, The Hole in the Wall Road, Moyne Road and Drumnigh Road.

Diversion and Road Closure signs will be in place.

Local access will be maintained at all times.
