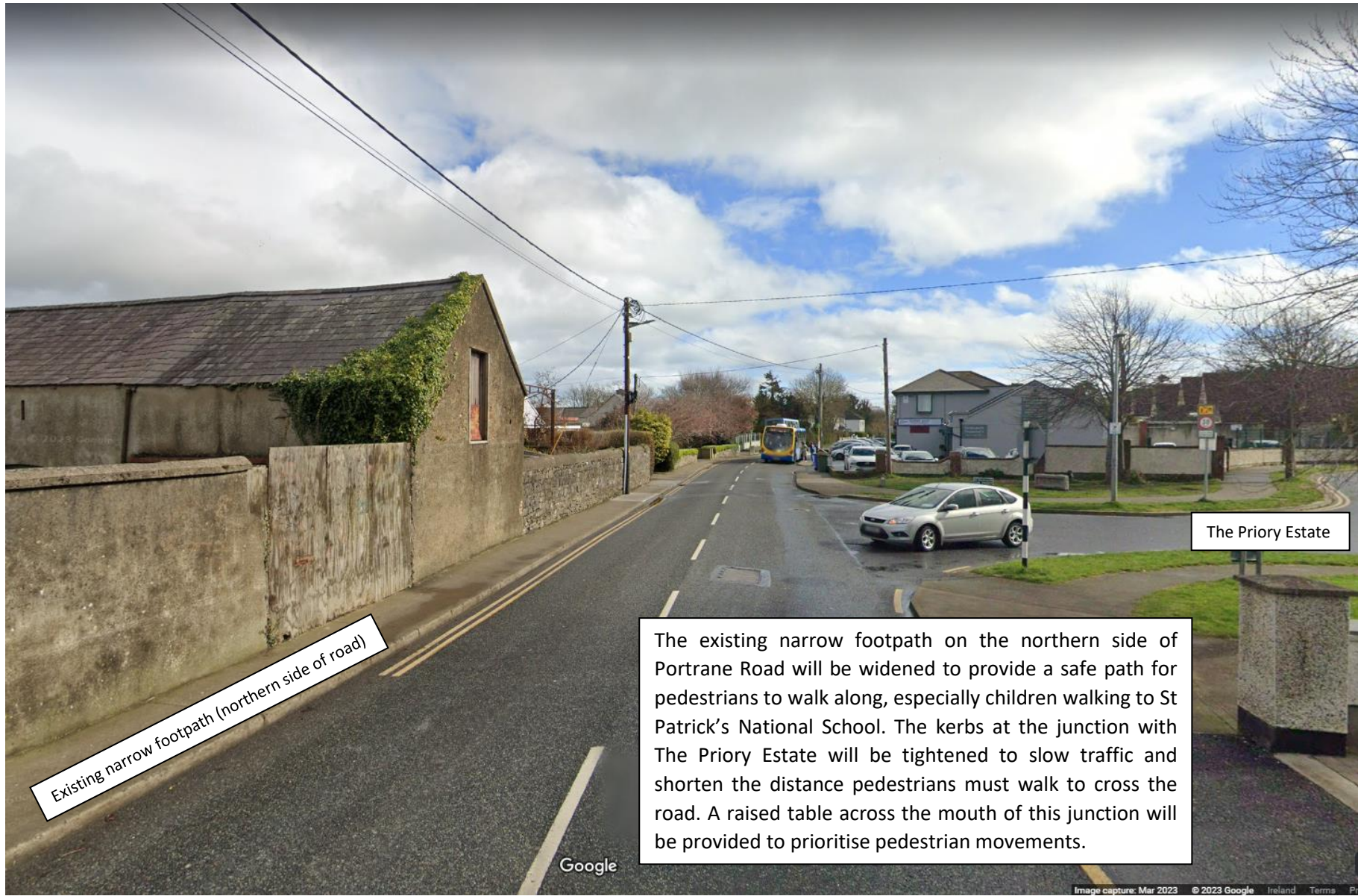


Carr's Mill Estate

The Portrane Road Enhancement Project will commence at the junction of Carr's Mill Estate. The kerbs at this junction will be tightened to slow traffic and shorten the distance pedestrians must walk to cross the road. A raised table across the mouth of this junction will be provided to prioritise pedestrian movements.

The Priory Estate

The existing narrow footpath on the northern side of Portrane Road will be widened to provide a safe path for pedestrians to walk along, especially children walking to St Patrick's National School. The kerbs at the junction with The Priory Estate will be tightened to slow traffic and shorten the distance pedestrians must walk to cross the road. A raised table across the mouth of this junction will be provided to prioritise pedestrian movements.

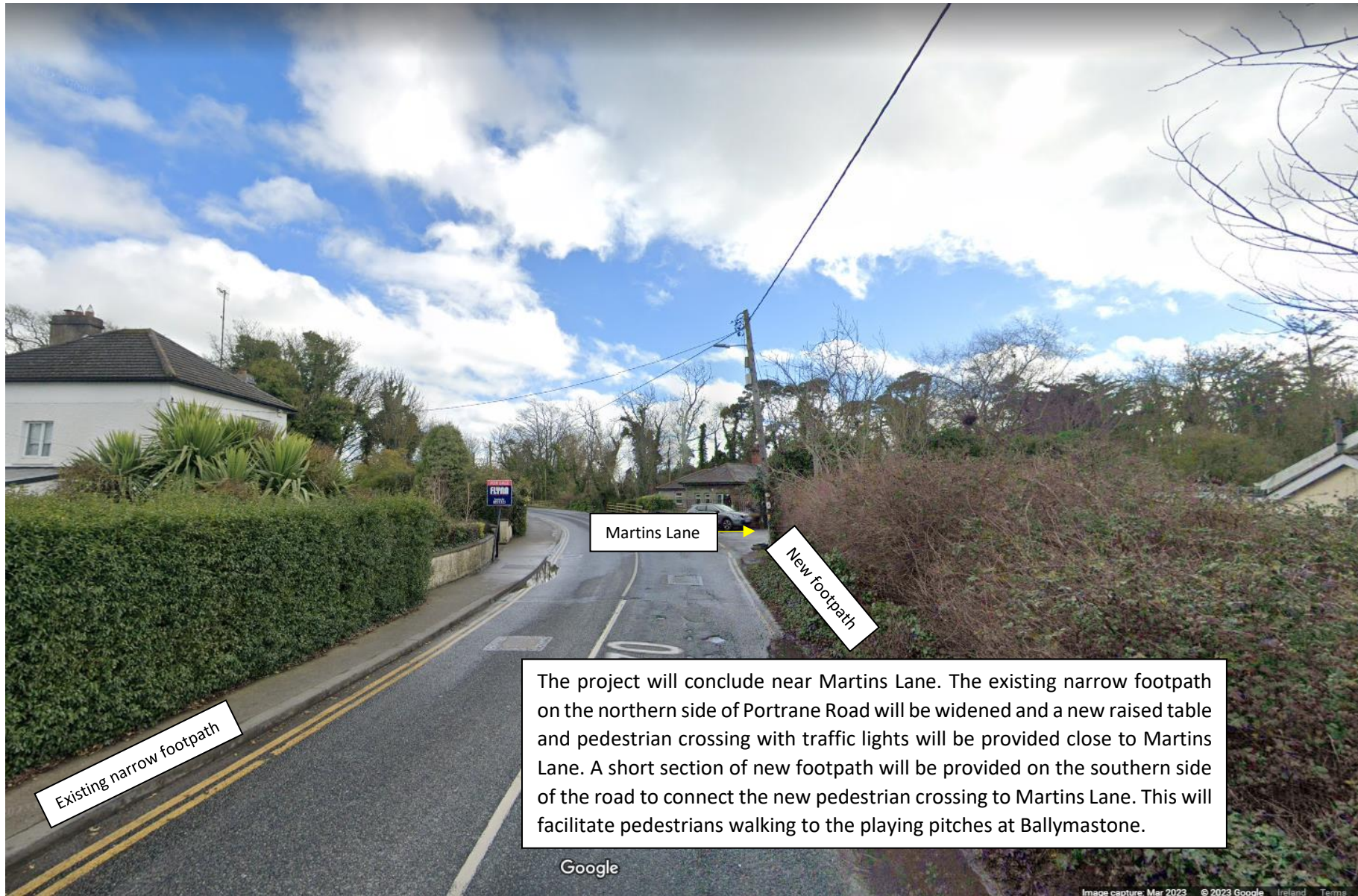


St Patricks National School

A new raised table will be provided in front of St Patrick's National School to calm traffic and emphasise the slow speed environment in front of the school. A new pedestrian crossing with traffic lights will be provided so that pedestrians have a safe place to cross the road. The existing narrow bus stop lay-by in front of the school will be widened so that buses can pull in fully and allow following traffic to pass safely.

Martins Lane

New footpath

The project will conclude near Martins Lane. The existing narrow footpath on the northern side of Portrane Road will be widened and a new raised table and pedestrian crossing with traffic lights will be provided close to Martins Lane. A short section of new footpath will be provided on the southern side of the road to connect the new pedestrian crossing to Martins Lane. This will facilitate pedestrians walking to the playing pitches at Ballymastone.
